### VOTE BY MAIL

### VOTE EARLY

Vote early at the County Clerk's office from:  
Monday through Friday, Sept. 27 - Oct. 19, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm  
Monday through Friday, Oct. 22 - Nov. 5, 8:00 am to 7:00 pm  
Saturday, Oct. 27 & Nov. 3, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm  
Sunday, Oct. 28 & Nov. 4, 10:00 am to 4:00 pm



### VOTE IN PERSON

Vote in person on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 6<sup>th</sup>, from 6 am - 7 pm. If you are in line by 7pm, you **MUST** be allowed to vote.
